We want you to get the most out of your UV lamps, so we have a list of the top 10 tips for taking care of your lamps:

- 1. Always wear latex gloves when handling the lamp
- 2. Before placing the lamp into the UV system, clean with Isopropanol Alcohol
- 3. Rotate the lamp every 100-200 hours to avoid deformation of the quartz
- 4. Ensure the UV system is clear of all external contamination, such as inks, paper dust etc.
- 5. Allow the lamp to cool for 5 minutes once the power has been turned off, before handling the lamp
- 6. Clean the lamp, UV system and reflectors every 500 hours to maintain the longest possible lamp life
- 7. Avoid excessive starts as this can cause contamination due to the electrodes throwing off tungsten into the lamp
- 8. Check reflectors and cooling systems periodically, to make sure they ar clean and free from distortion
- 9. Check that the electrical are tight and note eroded
- 10. Ensure that all lamps are installed into the system in accordance with OEM guidelines
- 11. Do not place hot lamps directly onto a flat or dirty surface, use a suitable metal rack to avoid contaminants making contact with the lamp body
